



Dear friends and supporters,

From the BBFI missionaries in Guatemala, we thank you for your prayers and concerns for our families and ministries. This past Sunday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>, Fuego Volcano had a massive eruption and sent a huge pyroclastic flow (a river of lava, rock and ash) which destroyed some villages at the base of the volcano. At this moment, the death toll has climbed to over 70 and is expected to continue rising. Over 300 are injured and more than 3,000 have lost everything.

The survivors in these communities have literally lost everything, and a number of our supporters and friends have contacted us asking how they can help and send donations. Because of that, we have set up a plan with BBFI Missions Office to aid those in need.

Our efforts will concentrate on the rebuilding of these communities. We will be partnering with local churches and schools with relief efforts to aide immediate and long term needs. Water, food, and clothing are some examples of immediate needs. Long term needs include the repairing and restoring of churches, schools, and homes.

This will ensure that those whose lives have been torn and left without hope will be helped by the generosity of those who have put supplies in place when they need them the most. If you would like to help with this relief effort you can send money through the Mission Office designated for "Disaster Relief" with a footnote - Guatemala.
