Current Events

Please continue to pray for Guatemala. Seven months of lockdown and strict government restrictions due to COVID-19 have been devastating for the economy. Because of this, many people are without work and basic necessities. We also were recently hit by two powerful hurricanes, which caused widespread flooding, destruction, and loss of life.

On top of all that, in the past few weeks there has been a lot of political unrest, including manifestations, violence, and burning of statues, buildings and vehicles to protest the corruption and apathy of our government leaders during this time of crisis.

Update on Churches

The Sumpango church has begun in person services, but we are complying with the many government restrictions and guidelines. We currently have two Sunday services with social distance seating, masks and other safety measures in place. Despite the restrictions, it was wonderful to be back in our church auditorium and worship as a body of Christ in person again!

The Ciudad Quetzal church is continuing with online services, but looking forward to using the campus again soon. Lord willing, we will transition to in person services early next year.

Our feeding centers have continued to give bags of food staples to families during this pandemic. We are thankful that our Manna feeding centers have been able to provide for the inscribed children with food supplies on a monthly basis.
