Under Lockdown

As we have written a number of times in the past, we are so thankful for ministry partners like you who pray for us and support us financially so that we can work in Guatemala... especially with the current COVID-19 crisis.

We have now been under a “stay at home” order or an official Government quarantine for over 100 days and there is no end in sight. The number of daily cases here continues to increase, along with strict guidelines to try to slow down this virus. Hospitals are full to capacity, and many Guatemalans are struggling and unable to work because of all the restrictions.

These are some of the current guidelines in place here in country:

- no travel in and out of Guatemala (closed borders)
- a mask must be worn outside of the house or a minimum fine of \$1,000
- no public transportation allowed
- no in-person meetings or gatherings of any kind
- cars are only allowed to travel every other day
- complete lockdown on Sundays
- daily 6 PM to 5 AM mandatory curfew

In these uncertain times, it is easy to focus on the negative or all the things we are not allowed to do. Instead, we are trying to stay positive and thankful for the many things we can still do to minister to others.

- preach and praise God through weekly online church services
- provide basic foods to our MANNA feeding center families and others in need
- encourage church members through phone calls and texts
- pray for friends and loved ones both here and around the world

We are thankful for God’s hand of protection on our family and ministries. At this time, we are safe, healthy, and continuing to serve the Lord here in Guatemala. Our daughter, Mikayla, was able to travel safely and be with grandparents in South Carolina and Florida. She plans on returning to Liberty University for classes in the fall.

Thanks again for your faithful support and prayers. We, as a family, are praying for you all as well during this crisis.
